Dear Dr. Pickavance

I am on my way to Princeton, via Geneva and London, having spent the past three weeks in Rome. If your laboratory is not closed for some holiday or other I should like to visit it on Wednesday, Oct 16 and Thursday Oct 17. I am not clear about the train time from London to Harwell; so I am assuming that I should ^(and can) return to London the night of the 16th.
